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This was a refurbishment that blurred the boundaries between the exterior and interior, creating a seamless relationship between inside and outside. The brief was to transform the existing dark, unsettling dwelling to a bright, animated family home.

This suburban family home is located within a Conservation Area, resulting in an amalgamation of modern and traditional elements. The front façade mirrors the mock Tudor style of its surroundings, but the defining feature can be found at the rear of the house, where the main living space has been merged to create a large, open plan space. This openness has been echoed through the use of apertures located on the roof, allowing ample amounts of daylight into the space.

The idea of boundaries being blurred was achieved through the installation of large glazed sliding doors, which span the width of the rear elevation. Through this vast opening, the living space has been extended into the rear garden.
